• **Industry Credential And Workforce Readiness**



In order to qualify for a diploma under the credential pathway, a student needs to do 2 things: Earn an industry-recognized credential or credentials worth 12 credential points in a single career field and earn points across three WorkKeys Assessment tests, Reading, Applied Mathematics, and Locating Information. Students must earn at least three points on each of the 3 test sections. Students in the Classes of 2018 and 2019 must earn a total of 13 points across the three WorkKeys test sections; students in the Class of 2020 and beyond must earn a total of 14 points.

## Competency Section

This section displays the student's progress toward meeting competency requirements. **ODE ticket 105768** - We are using program code 520110 for military enlistment. This is reported on the GQ record and meets the requirements of military enlistment prescribed in the law for this particular measure. The military graduation seal includes students who participated in 2 years of JROTC – and there is no way to differentiate these students from those who actually enlist.



**ODE ticket 103578** - According to HB110 (and the information I have received from the grad requirements folks), there will be a 4th alternative option added to demonstrate competency for students using the FY23 requirements for graduation. That 4th option will be a remediation free ACT/ SAT score. Currently, there is no program code for this option. Will ODE be adding that or will that be figured for students by ODE in the background based on ACT/SAT scores?

**ODE Reply** - There won't be a new program code for this. We'll be deriving it based on reported assessments.

\*\* Do not know if the developers will have a DAT for tracking this or not.

## Readiness Section

This section displays the student's progress toward meeting readiness requirements. There are 12 seals that can be earned to demonstrate readiness. A student must earn two seals, one of which must be a state-level seal.

- Seals that a student plans to earn will display as "planned" under the status column when the seal's *plans to earn* program code is entered on the Student Programs page.
- Earned seals will display as earned under the status column when the seal's program code is entered on the Student Programs page.
- Not all seals have earned program codes, some are considered earned based on other data.

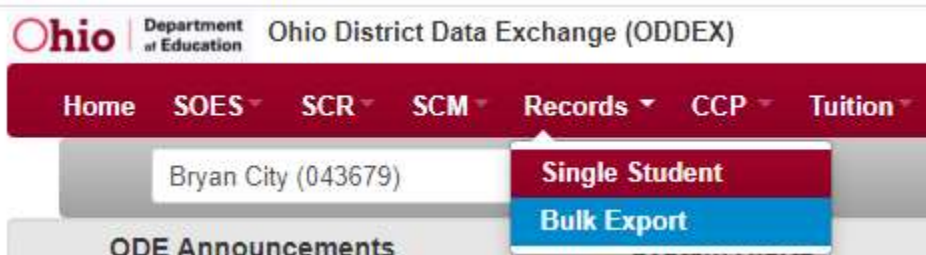
## Career Center Students – Industry Credential Seal “Earned” at Home Districts

If you'd like your Career Center students to show “Earned” in Grad Pathway and on your Transcript using the DAT's we provided (without a custom field) you will need to have the assessment records on your PowerSchool server in the FA tab for the students who earn the Industry Credential Seal.

To accomplish this (we are assuming the Career Center has reported the assessments and they are in ODDEX and that you and the Career Center are using the same SSID for the student) you search and select your Career Center students in your PowerSchool, then simply:

Do a quick export of the state\_studentnumber field for those students, save it as a CSV.

Log into ODDEX then go to Records to Bulk Export



Choose GW (and or GY) for the Assessment type and or enter in any dates if needed, Click Choose File – locate your CSV file then click upload
